DESTINATIONS

Ushuaia, ARGENTINA

Ushuaia, the youngest of Argentina's republic territories, is the capital of Tierra del Fuego, Antártida, and Islas del Atlántico Sur province. The island (Isla Grande de Tierra del Fuego) is separated from the rest of the continent by the Strait of Magellan, which belongs to Chilean territory. Often referred to as "The End of the World", Ushuaia is the gateway connection for Antarctica-bound cruises. Surrounded by Magallanic subpolar forests trimming the Martial Glacier range, the city is also the perfect base camp for exploring the surrounding landscape: majestic forests, lakes, rivers, and mountains.



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Day 1: Buenos Aires Ushuaia

Arrival at Ushuaia airport, meeting your guide and transfer to your hotel of choice.

Half Day Beagle Channel Navigation.

On this tour, you will navigate the Beagle Channel, seeing the extraordinary geography and wildlife of Tierra del Fuego while onboard modern boats that tour the surrounding islands and bays. Afterwards, the boat approaches Isla de los Pájaros (Birds' Island) where you will see an abundance of cormorants and imperial shags. Finally, you will reach Isla de los Lobos (Sea Lions' Island) to observe these mammals for a time, both sea lions and fur seals. On your return trip back, you will admire the symbolic Les Eclaireurs Lighthouse.



Rest of the day free for your enjoyment.

Overnight in Ushuaia.

Day 2: Ushuaia

Breakfast at the hotel.

Visita al Parque Nacional Tierra del Fuego con Tren del Fin del Mundo

Just 11 km from Ushuaia, you will visit the Tierra del Fuego National Park, which protects 63,000 hectares of the southernmost portion of the Subantarctic Forest. Unlike other Patagonian parks, this one is located near the sea coast. The mountain ranges, parallel to each other and that cross the park, divide it into quiet valleys that are difficult to access. While visiting Lapataia Bay and the shores of the Beagle Channel, you can admire the flora and fauna of this area: the small red fox, beavers, Andean condors, eagles and the Magellanic woodpecker. Next, you'll take a ride on the historic End of the World Train and learn how the railway was originally used by the local prison, which was the old center of Ushuaia. The prisoners were forced to load the train with firewood that they collected from the forest to be transported back to the prison. After an hour of travel, you will reach the last stop: the National Park station. Here, the guided tour will begin through its natural wonders, enjoying the flora and fauna either by vehicle or on a gentle walk.



Return to the hotel in the afternoon.

Day 3: Ushuaia

Breakfast at the hotel.

Lago Escondido y Lago Fagnano

Leaving Ushuaia and heading north via National Road Number 3, you will pass by the Tierra Mayor Valley and the Cerro Castor ski resort. There are bogs that spread to both sides of the road as you go along the bends across the Tierra del Fuego Andes. But the crossing itself is at the Garibaldi Pass, one of the most interesting points of the tour. While standing at 450 meters above sea level, after having travelled along for 60 kilometers, you'll be delighted to see Lake Escondido suddenly show up in the middle of the mountain range and at the foot of the Garibaldi. You will stop at the vantage point in order to quietly contemplate the striking beauty of the water and surrounding landscape, pausing here for pictures if you wish. Moving on from there, you will continue along the winding road that borders the walls of the mountain and follows along up to the other end of the lake, where the Bronzovic sawmill is located. Its chimney is constantly smoking and this venue represents the main economic activity in the center of the island. At this point, you will leave the principal road to take a gravel one towards Faganano Lake and during this time you will have a chance to see an ancient lenga forest, beaver dams, and various types of birds. A few miles ahead, you will reach a bay and Sur 54 Lodge where you will enjoy a wonderful homemade lunch while taking in stunning views of the incredible green water lake the lodge is on. Following lunch, you'll set out on a sauntering walk by the lake shore to relax some more and take in a closer view of the flora and fauna of this area. .



Lakes off road 4x4 - **opcional**

Discover the hidden majesty of the Southern Andes Mountain Range with this off-road adventure. Enjoy both a relaxing and also exhilarating trip with some serious off-road experiences! First, you'll explore the view of Lago Escondido (Hidden Lake) from Garibaldi Pass, a little wonder that hides at the bottom of a valley. Continuing onward in the 4X4 vehicle, you'll pass through the forest and across rivers towards the shore of Lake Fagnano, witnessing some truly unique views. Once you've arrived at the Fagnano Lodge refuge, you'll stop to take a typical Argentine barbecue lunch (Asado). This experience is accessible to anyone who wishes to have fun and break free from all limitations by getting to know, in-depth, a forest beyond description in words.



Return to the hotel in the afternoon.

Day 4: Ushuaia Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel.
